Summary Report for Financial Year Ending 31st May 2022

This carbon report provides the third-year reporting information for Claims Consortium Group in compliance with reporting requirements under The Companies (Directors' Report) and Limited Liability Partnerships (Energy and Carbon Report) Regulations 2018 to implement the UK government's policy on Streamlined Energy and Carbon Reporting (SECR).

During 2021/22 we have recorded our transport usage in actual litres of fuel instead of mileage which has improved the quality of information, and our fleet has progressively moved away from diesel to petrol, hybrid and full electric, which will continue as lease renewals arise.

The adopted methodology used is based on the Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Reporting Standard reporting on equivalent CO₂ emissions from organisational boundary. Information has been gathered from utility supplier invoices and transport mileage records, and collated into kWh for all corresponding UK based operations, directly owned or operated by Claims Consortium Group (i.e. the organisational boundary). These have been converted to equivalent tonnes of carbon dioxide (tCO₂e) using the published UK Government GHG Conversion Factors for Company Reporting for 2021.
